Year 13 important university information

- At this point around a quarter of you have not heard back from all of your universities. They say they will try to respond by May 19th...
- When you have heard from all of your universities you must reply to your offers. It is critical that your 'Firm' choice is the university you really want to go to. Your 'Insurance' choice, if you decide to have one, should only be your back-up choice and will usually have lower grade requirements. Your Insurance choice will only be available if you do not meet the requirements of your Firm choice. You will not be able to switch preferences (although you could withdraw from all offers and apply if there happen to be places in Clearing. Or you could reapply during a gap year). You have until the deadline 8th June.
- **Not holding any offers?** Don't worry! If all your universities rejected you or you declined all the offers you were made, you still have two options:
- Re-apply next year. Our careers officer and the sixth form team will still be here to help you even after you have left.
- Use UCAS Extra. UCAS automatically send you information about it and you can access on the
 website a list of courses which still have vacancies. You will be able to apply to one course at a time. If
 you need any help in using this service, come and see Mrs Dodsworth.
- If you might start university in September 2023, it's best to apply for finance before May 31. https://www.gov.uk/student-finance
- The Future Teaching Scholars Programme is now open for applications from those starting their degrees in 2023. It offers outstanding Maths and Physics students a new route into teaching, which includes a £15,000 grant whilst studying their Maths or Physics degree and a place on a salaried Initial Teacher Training course after finishing. 
