



Immigration officer - Civil Service

Immigration officers make decisions on whether people have the right to visit or stay in the country. You will work towards the government's aim of securing borders, reducing immigration, cutting crime and protecting national security.

You will check the landing cards of passengers and assess them to see if they meet the criteria to enter the country. You will also usually need to have lived in the UK for 5 years before applying. The qualifications you will need will depend on the role you're applying for, but you'll usually find it useful to have:

- 2 A levels at grade C (and for some roles, a degree)
- customer service skills
- **the ability to speak another language**

You can get into this job through: a college course, an apprenticeship working towards this role or applying directly.





Department Spotlight: DART

Here in the DART department, we have 8 members of staff who work across the all key stages. In DART we teach Art, Food and Nutrition, Product Design, Engineering, Textiles and Photography. Every teacher in the department has their own specialism and is an expert of that area. Some at home may remember Miss Hicks who has been here for 12 years, Mr Kimber who has been here for 11 years and Mrs Thomas (some may remember her as Miss Bull) who has been here for 10 years!

This term has been an extremely busy one! With preparation for exams happening in lessons! Art, Photography and Engineering have completed their big in class exams across KS4 and KS5. Product Design, Food, Engineering and Hospitality and Catering have all sent off their work to be moderated. We want to wish all of our year 11 and year 13s the best of luck in any DART exams they have left and thank them for all of their hard work this year!

For the last term all students in KS3 DT lessons will be finishing their final rotations and completing an exam, students across KS4 and KS5 will sit a practice exam and they will be completing practice coursework projects.

Some ways in which you can support your child at home in developing their skills across DART subjects are: encouraging them to cook and clean up at home, allow them to take photos of the things that interest them, encouraging them to be creative, giving them opportunities to draw, sketch and paint, showing them interesting products, problem solving, engaging them in your DIY projects and supporting them to eat healthily. The Department for Education (DfE) is providing funding to local authorities to coordinate a programme that provides healthy food and enriching activities to eligible children during the 2023 Spring, Summer and Winter school holidays. This is known as the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme.

Around 7,000 children across Swindon will be eligible for free holiday provision over these periods.

Places will be available at a range of holiday club providers and offer eligible children the opportunity to attend sessions four hours per day for four days over the Spring, four days per week for four weeks over the Summer and for four days over the Winter school holidays.

Children who take up a place at a free holiday club will have the opportunity to:

- eat more healthily over the school holidays, with a meal provided at each session
- be more active, by being involved in physical activities and a range of engaging and enriching activities to develop resilience, character and wellbeing
- be safe and not socially isolated over holiday periods
- most importantly, have fun with friends

The programme will grow over the summer, so a wider offer is available to families to access during this holiday period.

Eligibility

School aged children from any of the following categories are eligible to access the programme:

- Children in receipt of benefits related free school meals
- Children in need (must have a social worker working with the child)
- Child protection
- Young carers

Available HAF providers and the sessions they are offering will be published on the e-vouchers booking system.

Use the link in the message you receive to view a full list of activities available. You'll be given the option to book a space for your child.


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
