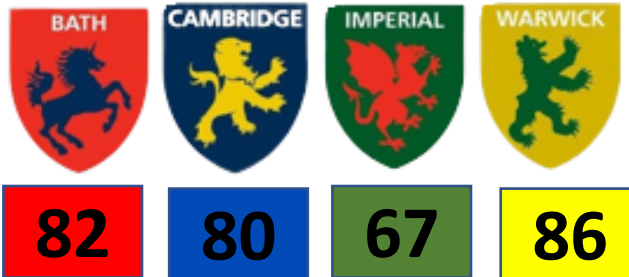

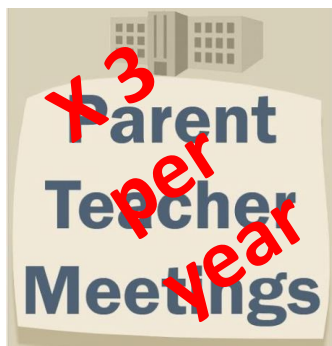

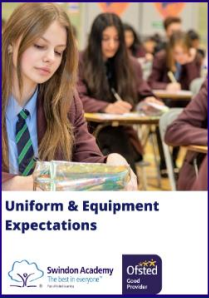

Last week @ the Academy

At Swindon Academy, we are committed to ensuring that every pupil can thrive both academically and personally and make it our mission to **get to know every pupil in the classroom**. During our training day last week, and following the most recent set changes, staff worked together to find out about every pupil in their new classes. This included an in depth look at how pupils had performed in their most recent exams and a chance to carefully study information around specific pupil need. Staff identified the gaps in both knowledge and skills for every pupil and then went on to review their planning to ensure that every pupil can make excellent progress this term.



An Introduction to the Western Front:
Last week students in Y9, 10 and 11 took part in a workshop on World War 1. Our guest speakers talked the students through all areas of life on the Western Front from the daily lives of soldiers, to the uniform and weapons they used and through the various stages of the Chain of Evacuation. This was a highly interactive session with the students actively participating by trying out the various uniform/weaponry and other war memorabilia that the presenters had brought in to show them.

Sporting Results

There was a fantastic result from our Year 8/9 girls football team this week. The girls produced one their best performances which secured a 3-0 win against a strong Dorcan side in the County Cup. A shout out to Holly and Lilly for their outstanding goals – especially the goal produced from a well-rehearsed corner kick. The girls now progress on in the next round of the County Cup.

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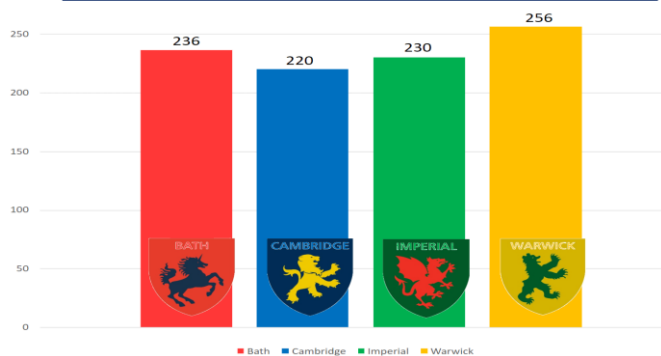

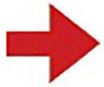
