Our AMAZING students and Staff really do make our school such a FANTASTIC place to work and learn in – this is why our Attendance team is so driven to support students and families in raising their attendance levels and reducing absences.

All students who achieve 100% each week are rewarded and receive epraise messages congratulating them. – they may even make into our 100% club.

For those families who's attendance is below 93% we are keen to work with and support. The support and intervention will come in the form of 1:1 meetings, Home visits, daily text messaging, and attendance barrier support plans. Unfortunately, at times we do have to contact Swindon Borough Council for those students and families whose attendance doesn't improve and don't engage with Academy support .

We are committed to working closely with The Education Welfare Team at Swindon Borough Council – This however does sometimes lead to families receiving Fixed Penalty Notices, Warning Letters and prosecution if a student's attendance falls below 90% and shows no sign if improving.

It's not too late to make it GREAT!!

If your Attendance is currently below 93%- It's not too late to start getting into GREAT Attendance habits by attending for 100% of this school year

So does Punctuality.....

What does being late say about you? - Often being late, can give a person the wrong impression about you, especially if it's the 1st time that someone meets you – if you are continuously late you may give the impression that you don't care and won't be trusted with important tasks and roles with responsibility.

If you are someone that is often late then "Never Be Late Again" with 5 Tips to Guarantee You'll Always be on Time!!!

- 1. Remind yourself why you want to be more punctual** – to stop detentions? Give the right impression? Rush less?
- 2. Know yourself** – If you know you're a late person, then act on it – take back control
- 3. Set your watch later 5 minutes earlier than it actually is** – I do this, it really does work.
- 4. Stop trying to squeeze in "just one more thing."** - this will give you time to do things properly and you'll feel less stressed
- 5. Prioritize your sleep** – sleep well, think well – act well!! - this should really be number 1

LAUNCH YOUR CAREER



The Department for Education (DfE) is providing funding to local authorities to coordinate a programme that provides healthy food and enriching activities to eligible children during the 2023 Spring, Summer and Winter school holidays. This is known as the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme.

Around 7,000 children across Swindon will be eligible for free holiday provision over these periods. Places will be available at a range of holiday club providers and offer eligible children the opportunity to attend sessions four hours per day for four days over the Spring, four days per week for four weeks over the Summer and for four days over the Winter school holidays.

Children who take up a place at a free holiday club will have the opportunity to:

- eat more healthily over the school holidays, with a meal provided at each session
- be more active, by being involved in physical activities and a range of engaging and enriching activities to develop resilience, character and wellbeing
- be safe and not socially isolated over holiday periods
- most importantly, have fun with friends

The programme will grow over the summer, so a wider offer is available to families to access during this holiday period.

Eligibility

School aged children from any of the following categories are eligible to access the programme:

- Children in receipt of benefits related free school meals
- Children in need (must have a social worker working with the child)
- Child protection
- Young carers

Available HAF providers and the sessions they are offering will be published on the e-vouchers booking system.

Use the link in the message you receive to view a full list of activities available. You'll be given the option to book a space for your child.
