Why Attendance Matters!!

For our children to gain the greatest benefit from their education, it is vital that they attend regularly, so your child should be at school, on time, every day the school is open unless the reason for the absence is unavoidable.

Nationally, pupils with the highest attainment and best rate of progress at the end of key stage 2 and key stage 4 have higher rates of attendance compared to those with the lowest attainment. There is a clear correlation nationally between poor school attendance and a number of extra-familial harms.

This includes crime (90% of young offenders had been persistently absent) and serious violence (83% of knife possession offenders had been persistently absent in at least 1 of the 5 years of study).

Every half-day absence from school has to be classified by the school (not by the parents), as either "authorised" or "unauthorised". This is why information about the cause of absence is always required.

Year 10 art students have made great progress in researching artists that link to their project themes and have started to create work in response to their research. This coursework is looking excellent – well done year 10.



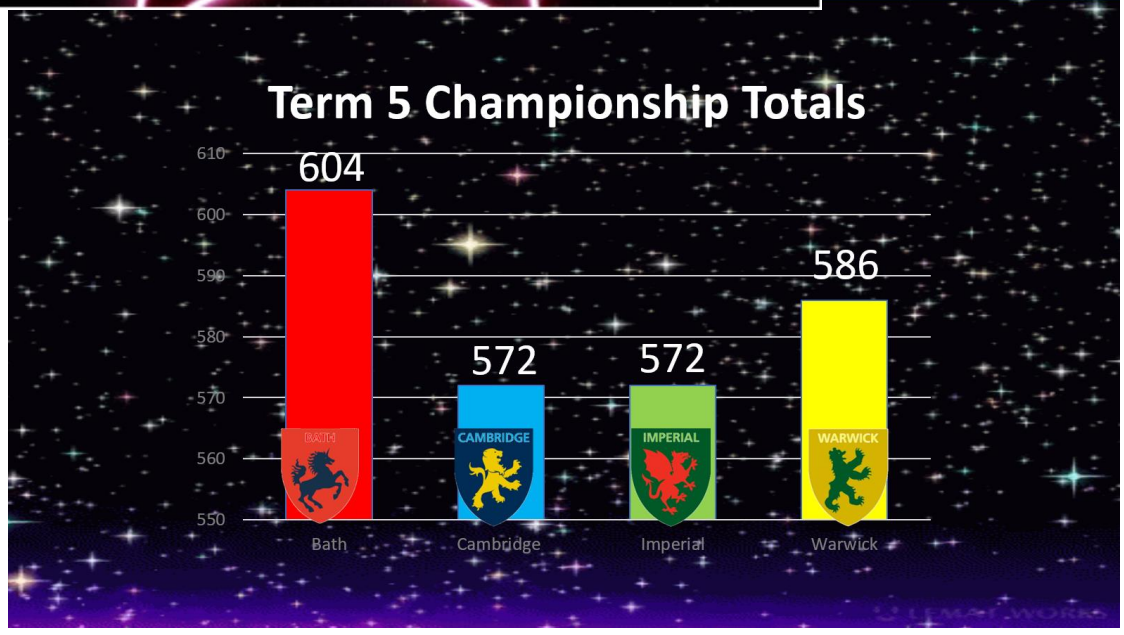

Prom tickets will be handed out at end of year 11 exams celebration assembly. This will only be for students who have paid. Prom tickets must be paid for by the 20th of June

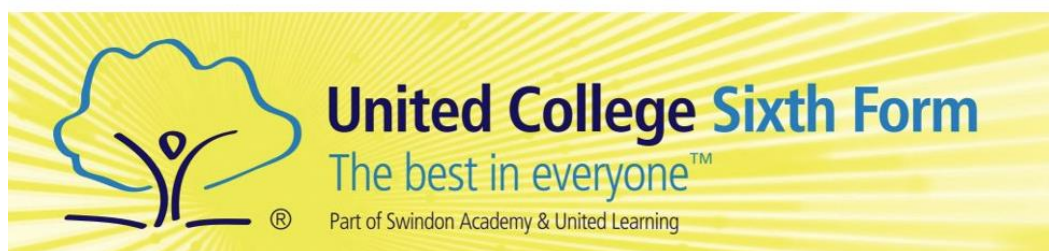
Governors' hearings for prom will talk place on 22nd of June. Times will be sent individually to students and students who are given permission to go will be given their ticket at the hearing.

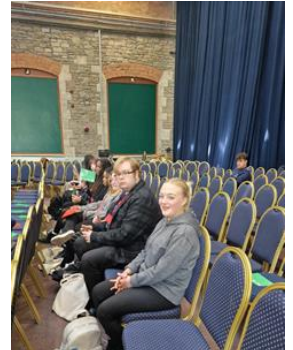

Essentially, ApprentiFest is a big event where a vast variety of companies come and sell their future opportunities to the next generation of employees. It was an excellent afternoon with presentations/talks and interactive workshops. Our students gained knowledge on Apprenticeships and good practice guides when applying for jobs. Criminal exploitation and gangs

We have advice about how to spot the signs of criminal exploitation and involvement in gangs and what support is available for children and young people.

What is criminal exploitation?

Criminal exploitation is child abuse where children and young people are manipulated and coerced into committing crimes.

What is a gang?

The word 'gang' means different things in different contexts, the government in their paper 'Safeguarding children and young people who may be affected by gang activity' distinguishes between peer groups, street gangs and organised criminal gangs.¹

- ◆ **Peer group**

A relatively small and transient social grouping which may or may not describe themselves as a gang depending on the context.

- ◆ **Street gang**

"Groups of young people who see themselves (and are seen by others) as a discernible group for whom crime and violence is integral to the group's identity."

- ◆ **Organised criminal gangs**

"A group of individuals for whom involvement in crime is for personal gain (financial or otherwise). For most crime is their 'occupation.'"

It's not illegal for a young person to be in a gang – there are different types of 'gang' and not every 'gang' is criminal or dangerous. However, gang membership can be linked to illegal activity, particularly organised criminal gangs involved in trafficking, drug dealing and violent crime.
