The programme aims to provide information, advice and guidance on higher education and Oxford to academically able students, and staff members, in non-selective state schools with little history of student progression to Oxford

These events aim to explain the importance of GCSE results and post-16 choices to students and their teachers	<p>The study days offer students the chance to experience their chosen subject through a day of academic sessions run by Oxford tutors.</p> <p>These events bring 500 state school students to Oxford during three days in March. The aim of the day is to give these students a taste of university-level study in a subject that they are interested in, as well as to give them an insight into life as a student, studying and living in the Oxford college setting</p>	This event is aimed at students who are about to submit an application to the University of Oxford, and provides information and advice on personal statements, tests and interviews.
