In our Primary Phase our PSHE programme begins with the use of PATHs. PATHs® (Promoting Alternative Thinking Strategies) Programme for Schools (UK Version) is an evidence-based social and emotional learning programme for primary schools. It is taught by classroom teachers as a regular part of the school day and programme content focuses on five domains of social and emotional development: » Self-control » Emotional understanding » Positive self-esteem » Relationships » Interpersonal problem solving skills; all of which are skills that will be needed as children move towards the world of work.

Alongside this programme children are introduced to the world of work through a programme of visitors and topic lessons. This year this has included input from Npower's World of Work assemblies and workshops as well as visits from the police and the fire service. During assemblies and through displays other information about jobs is shared to further support pupils understanding.
