

Work from Home - Instructions for individual students who are self-isolating/shielding/EBSA

An individual student is self isolating: This may be anything from 1 day to 10 school days in a block.

An individual student is shielding following medical advice: This may be for multiple weeks

An individual student that is currently experiencing EBSA whilst the Attendance Team work with the student to enable a full return to the Academy.



At Key Stage 3:

Students will need to access their Termly Knowledge Organiser from EPRAISE or the school website.

Alongside each Knowledge Organiser there is a Work from Home document that directs students and parents to relevant work for each subject.

Students will be expected to follow their school timetable to know what subjects to study each day.

Students will complete work in their Prep Books, which will be with students at all times. Students can also use their electronic devices to work from.

Students will be expected to complete all Prep work that is set for them.

KEY STAGE 3 Support: for general support, students are asked to message Mr Nick Warren via Epraise. Students can also message their teachers to send in work they have completed via electronic attachment or by photographing their work. It is important for students remember that their teachers are busy teaching students in school, so may not be able to answer messages asking for subject support. Students can use the 'I need help with' function on EPRAISE for all other support.
